
BR5 – BRAMPTON VALLEY WAY



Brampton Valley Way (14 miles) is part of Midshires way which runs from Salcey Forest in the South of the county to Leicestershire (49 miles). Access to BVWay for horse riders currently spans from 'Tom Merry Lane', up to the A14 above Draughton and stops at the Kelmarsh Tunnel approx. 8 miles. There is also access between Kelmarsh and Great Oxendon Tunnels.

There is no available parking along Tom Merry lane as it's quite narrow, although there is a parking layby close to the bottom of the lane just off Spratton Road at grid reference SP724673

Draughton Crossing car park has some space towards the back of the car park, but please check first. There are other options and you may already know of some. Please refer to Ride BR7 — BVWay/Cottesbrooke/Lamport which also has suggestions for parking along the route which can be used to access Brampton Valley Way.

There are two other trails to plot which are illustrated in 'Northamptonshire on Horseback', that relate to Brampton Valley Way. One from Houghton Crossing and the other from Great Oxendon between the Kelmarsh and Great Oxendon Tunnels. These will be added to list of circular rides in due course.

NB: British Horse Society is currently looking into ways of extending the access above the A14 and below Tom Merry Lane. We will be adding more detailed information to this page when available.
